Notification of Collection and use of Social Security Number: FL statute 119.071(5); GCSC collects SSNs for use in performance of the College's duties and responsibilities for the following purposes: identification, verification, & creation of student records necessary for conducting the College's business; billing & payments; data collection; tax reporting. Federal law requires that we protect SSNs from disclosure to unauthorized parties.
