Information for Residency Classification

A Florida "resident for tuition purposes" is a person who has, or a dependent person whose parent or legal guardian has, established and maintained legal residence in Florida for at least twelve (12) months. Residence in Florida must be as a bona fide domicile rather than for the purpose of maintaining a residence incident to enrollment at an institution of higher education. To qualify as a Florida resident for tuition purposes, you must be a U.S. citizen, permanent resident alien, or legal alien granted indefinite stay by the Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services. Other persons not meeting the twelve (12) month legal residence requirement may be classified as Florida residents for tuition purposes only if they fall within one of the limited special categories authorized by the Florida Legislature and Florida Board of Education. All other persons are ineligible for classification as a Florida "resident for tuition purposes." Living in or attending school in Florida will not, in itself, establish legal residence. Students who depend on out-of-state parents for support are presumed to be legal residents of the same state as their parents. (s.1009.21, F.S.)

(REQUIRED: a copy of marriage certificate, claimant's voter registration, driver's license, and vehicle registration.)
- E. I was previously enrolled at a Florida state institution and classified as a Florida resident for tuition purposes. I abandoned my Florida domicile less than 12 months ago and am now reestablishing Florida legal residence.
- F. According to the Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services, I am a permanent resident alien or other legal alien granted indefinite stay and have maintained a domicile in Florida for at least 12 months. (REQUIRED: immigration documentation and proof of Florida residency status)
- G. I am a member of the armed services of the United States stationed in Florida on active military duty pursuant to military orders, my home of record is Florida, or I am a member's spouse or dependent child. (REQUIRED: a copy of military orders or DD2058 showing home of record)
- H. I am a full-time instructional or administrative employee employed by a Florida public school, community college, or institution of higher education or I am the employee's spouse or dependent child. (REQUIRED: a copy of employment verification)
- I. I am part of the Latin American / Caribbean Scholarship program. (REQUIRED: a copy of scholarship papers)
- J. I am living on the Isthmus of Panama and have completed 12 consecutive months of college work at the FSU Panama Canal branch or I am the student's spouse or dependent child. (REQUIRED: a copy of marriage certificate or proof of dependency)
- K. I am a full-time employee of a state agency or political subdivision of the state whose student fees are paid by the state agency or political subdivision for the purpose of job-related law enforcement or corrections training. (REQUIRED: a copy of employment verification)
- L. I am an active member of the Florida National Guard who qualifies under s.250.10(7) and (8) for the tuition assistance program.
- M. I am an active duty member (or spouse or dependent child of a member) of the Armed Services of the United States attending a public community college or university within 50 miles of the military establishment where the member is stationed, if such an establishment is within a county contiguous to Florida.
- N. I am an active duty member (or spouse or dependent child of a member) of the Canadian military residing or stationed in Florida under the North American Air Defense (NORAD) Agreement, attending a public community college or university within 50 miles of the military establishment where the active duty member is stationed.
- O. I am an active duty member (or spouse or dependent child of a member) of a foreign nation's military who is serving as a liaison officer and am residing or stationed in Florida, attending a community college or state university within 50 miles of the military establishment where the foreign liaison officer is stationed.
