I. Call to Order Mr. Cramer called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m.

II. Welcome Mr. Cramer opened the meeting by welcoming the committee members, Chancellor Hebda, and Trustees.

III. 2025-26 College Budget Discussion Mr. Cramer called on Ms. Hapner, Dean of Business Affairs, to present Gulf Coast State College 2025-26 Proposed Unrestricted Current Fund Budget.

Ms. Hapner, presented a summary of the 2025-26 Budget Assumptions and 2025-26 Proposed Budget.

Gulf Coast State College 2025-26 Budget Assumptions

- No tuition or fee increase
- Enrollment based on 7% increase over 2024-25 due to Gulf Coast Guarantee Scholarship Program and continued recovery of enrollment decline due to Covid 19
- Actual state appropriations from 2025-26 General Appropriations Act
- Estimated Industry Certification funds based on 2024-25
- Nursing Performance Allocation from 2025-2026 General Appropriations Act
- Personnel: Includes an increase in salaries of 2.0% for all full-time employees, with a minimum increase of \$1,000
- Current expenses increased due primarily due to increases in facility maintenance and technology costs associated with SaaS.
- Capital outlay decreased due to completing installation of security cameras in 2024-25.

Discussion followed regarding a number of topics related to the budget.

Mr. Hall made a motion to approve the proposed 2025-26 budget and recommend it for approval to full board at the next regular meeting on August 28, 2025. Mr. Powell seconded; the motion passed unanimously.
