What Students Will Gain by Attending:

- **Individualized Feedback:** Each student will receive a 20-minute session with a college professor, focusing on personalized tips for improving their performance.
- **Performance Enhancement:** Tailored feedback will help participants refine their technique, musicality, and interpretation to excel in their future performances.
- **Insight into College-Level Music Programs:** Engage with college faculty and gain insights into what it's like to study music at a collegiate level.
- **Preparation for Future Auditions:** Learn how to fine-tune your performances in preparation for competitions, auditions, and other important events.
- **Performance Practice:** Put the feedback into practice at a recital on the Mainstage at 3:00 p.m. after the workshop.
