Treetings colleagues! I realized upon coming back to GCSC in April that numerous faculty and staff are unaware of what TRiO does. It subsequently became apparent that occasionally sending a newsletter would be helpful to inform everyone about our services, events, and impact. Accordingly, TRiO humbly submits the first installment of our semesterly newletter-titled "Works!"

To provide you with an initial overview, the Federal TRIO Programs are outreach and student services grants offered by the U.S. Department of Education to provide assistance for people from disadvantaged backgrounds. TRIO started with three grants back in the 1960s, but now includes eight programs targeted to help low-income families, first-generation college students, and individuals with disabilities as they progress through the academic pipeline. Each grant requires a competitive proposal, and awards are approved for five-year increments. GCSC currently has three TRiO grants-Upward Bound (UB), Student Support Services (SSS), and the Educational Opportunity Center (EOC). Please continue reading below for an update on each program.
