



Supply List

Acrylic Painting

- One tube each of the following acrylic colors: Titanium White, Mars Black, Cadmium Yellow Medium, Cadmium Red Medium, Ultramarine Blue, Raw Umber, Cerulean Blue and Yellow Ochre.
- 6 Canvasses at least 12" x 12"
- Palette
- Brushes varying in size from 1/8" to 1"
- Acrylic Matte Medium
- Students are welcome to bring any other paint colors and materials that they would like to use.

Beginning Sewing Class

- A sewing machine in good working order, a straight stitch pressure foot, a zipper foot, and a walking foot are helpful but not required.
- Fabric shears, paper scissors, straight pins, hand sewing needle, seam ripper & thread
- Measuring tape and sewing gauge, plastic sewing ruler min 4" wide
- Chosen fabric for each project (Will be discussed during the first class.)

Beginning Watercolor Painting

- A set of watercolor paints that includes blue, yellow, and red. Can be cakes or tubes. Recommended: the Chalkold Watercolor paint set, Meeden, Artisto, or Artec.
- A set of watercolor round brushes in the sizes 2(small), 8(medium), and 12(large). Recommended: Master Touch, Golden Maple, Meeden, or Royal & Langnickel.
- A pad of cold press 140lb. Watercolor paper sizes 8x10", 9x12", or equivalent size. Recommended: Master Touch, Deyton.
- Paint pallet
- Pencil
- White block or kneaded eraser
- Black felt-tip pen
- White gel pen
- Cup, jar, or something to hold a fair amount of water
- Little spray bottle
- ½" Masking Tape or Painters' tape
- Blow dryer
- Roll of paper towels

- Glue Sticks
- Ribbon for Decoration (favorite colors or themed)
- Twine/Rope (approx. size ¼" thick, just not thin rope)
- 1 set of battery-operated twinkle lights

Drawing from Life for Fun

Required Materials:

- Ebony Pencil
- Pencil Sharpener
- Vine Charcoal
- Kneaded Eraser or your favorite type of eraser
- Pencil box
- T-shirt rag or drawing chamois
- 8"x12" Sketchbook or larger
- 19" x 24" Drawing pad

Optional materials:

- Drawing Board
- Portfolio large enough to hold your drawings
- Spray fixative
- Drawing tape

Intermediate Watercolor Painting

- Paper: 140lb. Cold press, 8x10", 9x 12", or equivalent size. Deyson, Arches, Meeden (100%Cotton if you can)
- Paint: Tubes or cakes. Red, yellow, blue, green, purple, pink, orange, brown. My favorite is Daniel Smith.
- Brushes: Round brush set including a small (2), medium (8), and large (12)
- ½-1" Masking or painter's tape
- Roll of paper towels
- Palette with wells
- Small spray bottle/mister
- Blow dryer
- Graphite pencil, 4H or 6H
- Black felt pen 0.3 or 0.5
- White gel pen
- Kneaded or white block eraser
- Cup, jar, or vessel for holding water
