



Call for Exhibition Proposals

Gulf Coast State College Amelia Center Gallery seeks proposals for the exhibition of artwork in all media, with particular emphasis on new, emerging, and local artists. Proposals for solo and group exhibitions are reviewed on an ongoing basis. Artists are invited based on merit, variety of exhibits, and relevance to the college art program. We offer 70% commission on all sales, publicity, a reception, as well as lecture and workshop opportunities.

Eligibility

Proposals are open to all artists without residency restrictions. Art must be original and have been completed within the last five years.

Deadline and Fees

There are no fixed deadlines or submission fees. Please allow up to 16 weeks for review of your materials.

Submission Guidelines

To submit a proposal, please provide the following:

- Printable Application or Electronic Application
- Artist statement and resume
- Up to 15 digital images of the work
- Images list including, titles, year, dimensions, and media.

All images must be high quality, high resolution (300 dpi) files saved in the JPEG format. Files must be between 1500 and 1920 pixels on the longest side. File size must not exceed 5 MB.
