Instructions:

One of your parents were pre-approved for a Direct Parent PLUS loan, which makes you ineligible for additional Federal Direct Unsubsidized loan. Section 428 of the Higher Education Act gives financial aid administrators the authority to determine whether a dependent undergraduate student is eligible for increased Federal Direct Unsubsidized loan amounts due to exceptional circumstances that would prevent a parent from borrowing a Direct Parent PLUS Loan. Examples of such exceptional circumstances include, but are not limited to the following:

- *An incarcerated parent.*
- *A parent who has filed for bankruptcy and has provided a letter from the bankruptcy court stating that as a condition of the bankruptcy filing, the parent may not incur any additional debt.*
- *A parent with income limited to documented public assistance or disability benefits.*
- *A parent unable to repay a Direct Parent PLUS Loan due to an existing debt burden or income-to-debt ratio.*
- *A parent who is not a U.S. citizen or permanent resident or is not able to provide evidence from the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Service that he or she is in the United States for other than a temporary purpose with the intention of becoming a citizen or permanent resident.*

Please submit this form along with the letter & documentation described in Section I to the Financial Aid Office in order to appeal for additional Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan funding, despite your parent's recent Parent PLUS pre-approval.

Section I: Letter & Documentation

Please attach a signed/dated letter from the parent that was pre-approved for a Direct Parent PLUS Loan detailing why s/he would not be able to repay the Direct Parent PLUS Loan they were pre-approved for. Also, please submit supporting information to substantiate the details of your parent's letter.

I have not knowingly or intentionally provided any false statements or fraudulent documentation.
