Instructions:

Male students between ages 18 and 25 must register with the Selective Service to be eligible to receive federal financial aid funds. This requirement covers men residing in the United States who are U.S. citizens and men residing in the United States who are noncitizens. Per section 484(n) of the Higher Education Act, when the Selective Service determines that a male Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) applicant did not register properly, he is not eligible for Federal Student Aid funds. A student in this situation first needs to attempt to explain and document, if applicable, that he qualifies for one of the exemptions to the Selective Service's registration requirement.

If a student cannot clearly demonstrate that he qualifies for one of the Selective Service's exemptions then he may appeal to the Financial Aid Office. Students in this situation need to explain and document why they feel they did not knowingly and willfully fail to register for the Selective Service, despite the requirement to do so. The documentation necessary for such an appeal includes a letter from the student explaining his situation and the response the student received from the Selective Service regarding the student's status information letter request. Instructions for submitting a status information letter request to the Selective Service may be found online at www.sss.gov.

Please submit this form along with the letter & documentation described in Section I along with the certification in Section II to the Financial Aid Office in order to appeal your Selective Service Determination.

Section I: Letter & Supporting Documentation

Please attach a signed/dated letter detailing why you feel that you did not knowingly and willfully fail to register with the Selective Service. Also, please attach any pertinent documentation, e.g. the response you received from the Selective Service regarding your status information letter request.

Section II: Certification

I hereby certify that all the information contained in my Selective Service Appeal is true and complete. I have not knowingly or intentionally provided any false statements or fraudulent documentation. I understand that if I am found to have knowingly or intentionally given false or fraudulent statements and/or documentation, this appeal will be denied and my federal aid eligibility will be jeopardized.
